► Scotts Tip

Getting the right balance of cations in a relatively inert potting mix is a challenge in preventing deficiencies and toxicities. The significant cations of Calcium, Magnesium, Potassium and Sodium interact with each other and maintaining the correct ratio between them is important.

While Calcium is added via liming materials and gypsum, Potassium via Osmocote or soluble forms and Sodium often delivered through poor irrigation water, Magnesium is often in short supply and made relatively unavailable by the higher additions of the other cations.

Magrimax corrects this potential imbalance throughout the crop life.
